

No Public Access to SCA Facilities! pg 1 of 3

- SCA premises are **only** for members.
- SCA members greatly **benefit** if **no** exception is allowed for food service facilities.
- **LV Strip tourist access** would **damage** all aspects of our **lifestyle** and facilities.
- With a **break-even/amenity policy**, members-only access to food **premises** will **not** require additive **member assessments**.
- A members + guests only policy for Trumpets & catering **MUST** be tested **before** a decision to open up to public access is considered.

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- 1. Significantly degrade member access to facilities, parking and food services. [With 12,000 residents in the future, saturation & high noise will occur during prime times.]**
- 2. Block member enjoyment due to competition for Hanneman Hall, party rooms, lawn, etc.**
- 3. Wear out facilities because of intense use of facilities, equipment and furnishings**
- 4. Drive member dues up to pay for increased wear of facilities and equipment.**

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5. **Reduce contractor motivation to satisfy SCA member requirements. Public access will encourage pursuit of highly profitable public (tourist) business from the LV Strip.**
6. **Require implementing the extra costs and financial management efforts to participate in gross revenue sharing.**
7. **Require implementing a complex security system & barriers (could exceed \$500,000 in 5-year, life-cycle costs.)**
